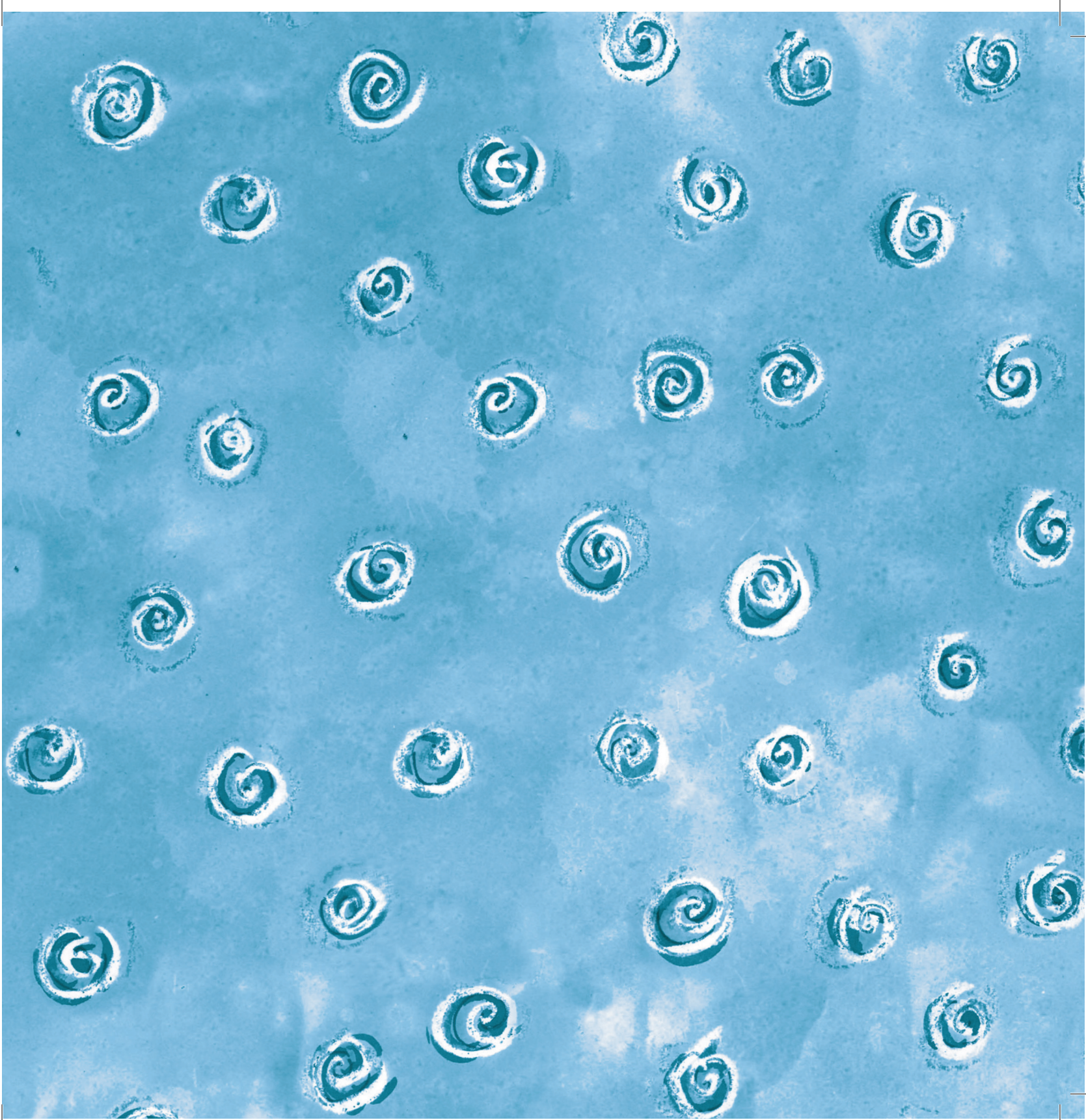



and Summer went by...



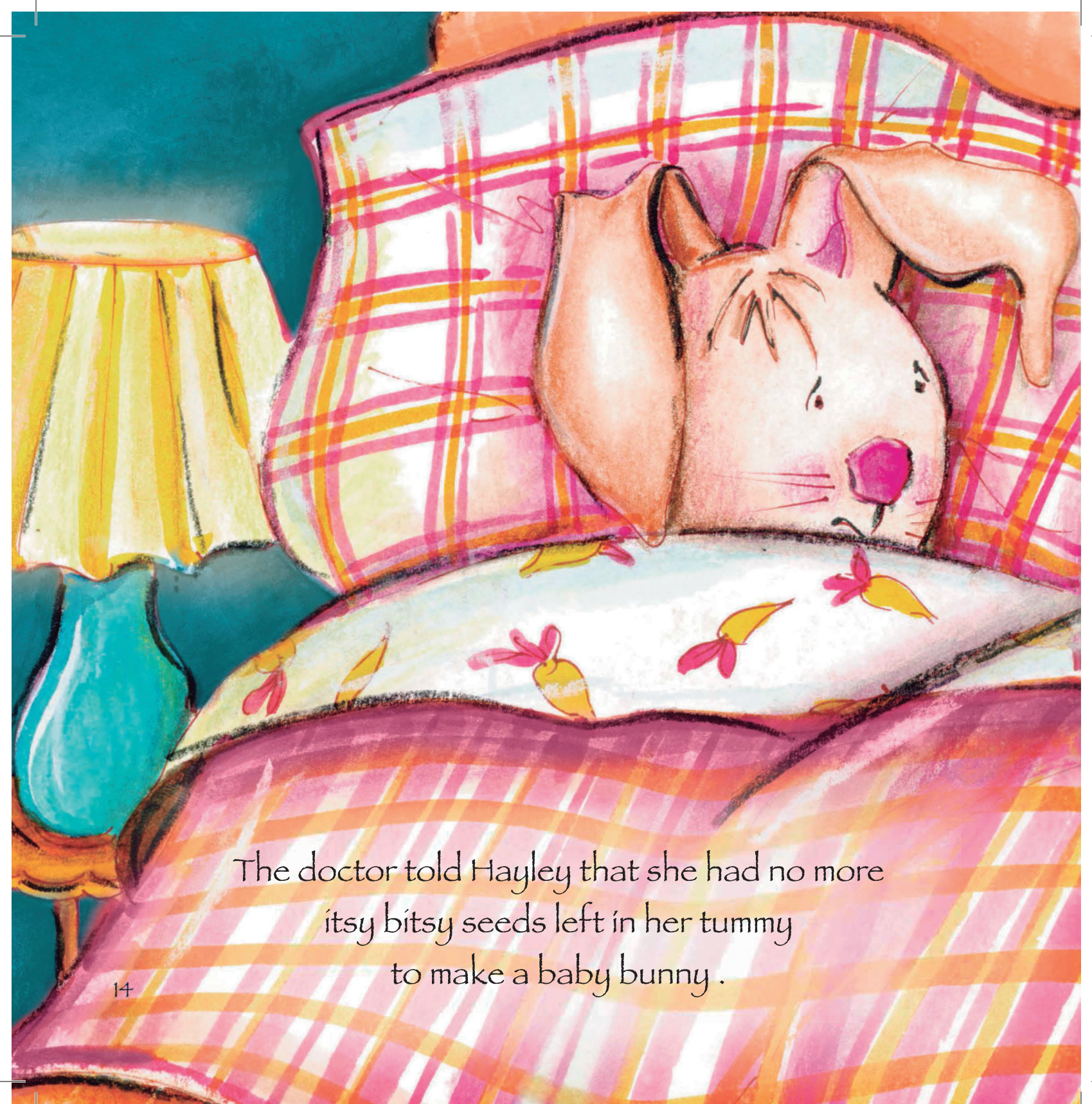
and Autumn went by...

to have her baby bunny.


And then Craig said,

said Craig.

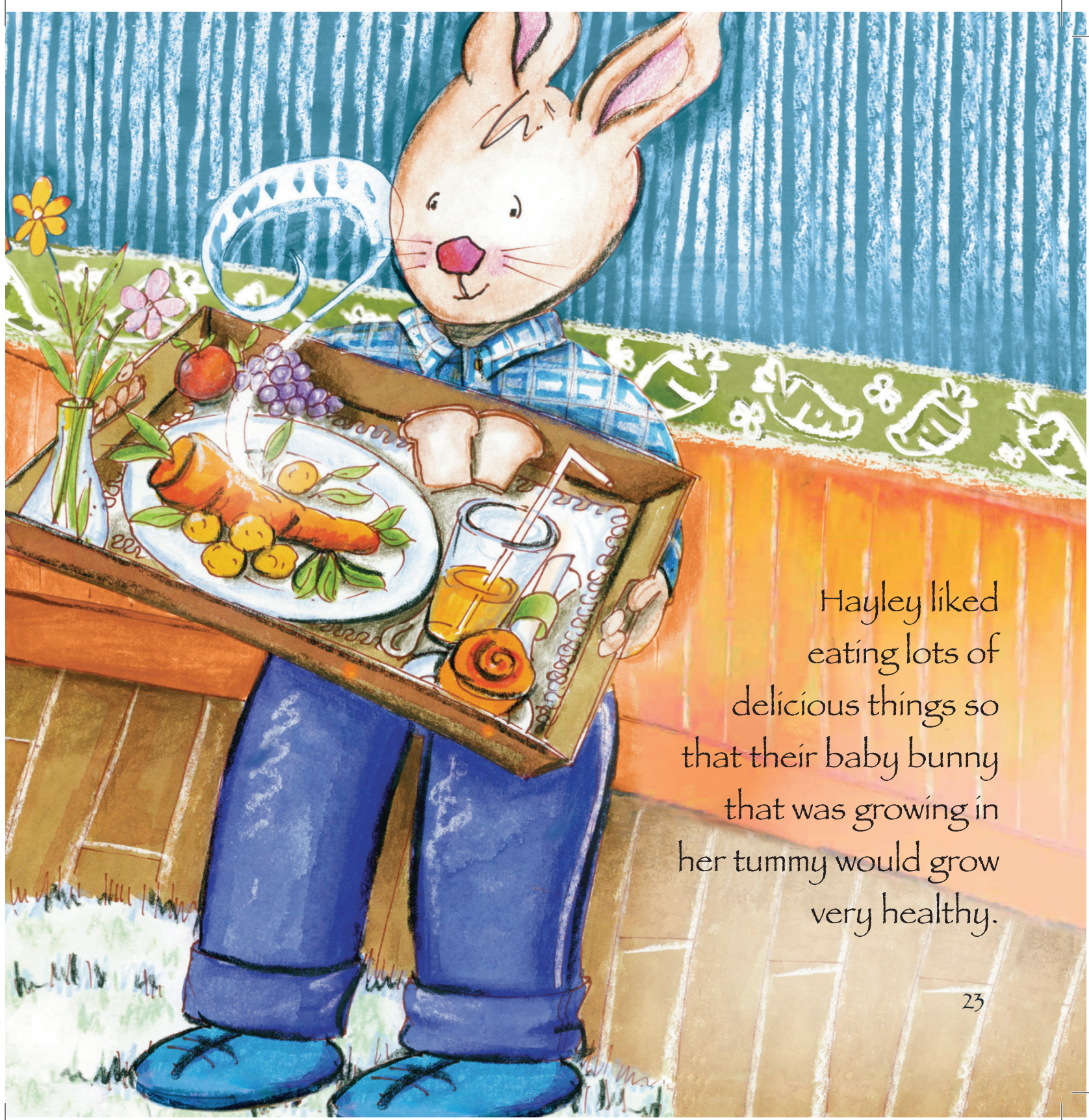






Soon Hayley's
